Dry to taste and medium-bodied, a tightly focused and linear flow of complex nectarine and flinty flavours is a feature on the palate. The barrel-ferment layers provide nuance and detail. The fruit has a subtle richness and succulence adding to the creamy mouthfeel, which is countered by a fine, grainy, textural backbone and fresh, brisk acidity. The wine leads to a long, lingering, dry finish. This is a concentrated barrel-influenced Sauvignon Blanc with complex detail and tight textures.
